The next AMI 3-6 Diploma Course will be held in Auckland, New Zealand, between January 2023 and May 2024 with AMI 3-6 Director of Training, Carol Potts.

Please download the course brochure, application form, course details and a list of essential background reading for the 3-6 course.

Please also complete the application form and return with the requested information. Students are required to be over 18 years of age.

The course enrolment process and course fees are as follows:

- Submission of an application form with accompanying information (see the enclosures page of the application form for details of the information required)
- Observation in a Montessori environment (a list of environments available for observation is enclosed)
- An interview by one of the Training faculty, this may be face to face, online or by phone.
- Notification in writing regarding course acceptance.
- The signing of an Enrolment Agreement & MMEF Student Contract with payment of an enrolment fee of \$500 + G.S.T.

Course Fees

- **Option 1** - \$9,500 + GST to be paid by 3rd November 2022
 - **Option 2**
 - Instalment 1 - \$7,000 + GST to be paid by 3rd November 2022
 - Instalment 2 - \$3,000 + GST to be paid by 7th August 2023
- Or for centres only:
- **Option 3**
 - Instalment 1 - \$5,000 + GST to be paid by 3rd November 2022
 - Instalment 2 - \$3,000 + GST to be paid by 7th August 2023
 - Instalment 3 - \$2,000 + GST to be paid by 8th January 2024

Payment of \$65.00 annual AMI membership prior to the commencement of the course. All payments refer to New Zealand Dollars.
